Work session called to order at 7:03 pm.

1. Director Robrock presented to the Council on the proposal to participate in a transit study with the City of Iowa City and Cambus. Robrock explained that the purpose of the study for the City of Coralville would be to examine the current interchange in downtown Iowa City as it relates to changes made to Clinton Street by the City of Iowa City. In addition, Robrock said the city would benefit by gathering information on ways to better serve the citizens of Coralville and become more efficient. Robrock stated that Iowa City would also be studying going to a “no fare” system, but Coralville declined to participate in that aspect of the study. Upon questions from the Council, Robrock also indicated that the study would not include any review of service provided by Johnson County SEATS nor would consolidation of systems be included in this study. The total cost to Coralville would be 10% of the study, or \$22,5000.
2. City Administrator Hayworth reminded the Council of the Joint Meeting at Coralville on July 15 and council members requested an arena update be added to the agenda. Hayworth also showed the council the location and proposal to place storage units in the Town Center area behind King’s Materials and also updated the Council on properties for sale or redevelopment along U.S. Highway 6.
