

**Coralville City Council
Work Session
August 8, 2023**

Present: Mayor Meghann Foster, Council Members Mike Knudson, Mitch Gross, Hai Huynh and Keith Jones

Staff Present: Deputy City Administrator Ellen Habel; Parks and Recreation Director Sherri Proud, Finance Director Melissa Christiansen and City Attorney Kevin Olson

Mayor Foster opened the meeting at 7:15 pm.

Parks and Recreation Sherri Proud outlined the Indoor Pool and Recreation Master Plan. Proud stated that the indoor pool is 35 years old and the useful life on such facilities averages around 30 years. Proud discussed the issues that have been occurring with hosting the swim teams (now Liberty and West High share a high school team). When the indoor pool was constructed, the school district contributed 1/3 of the costs to host the swim teams. However, West and Liberty want to separate into 2 programs, however, North Liberty does not have the capacity to host the Liberty teams. Proud stated that the school district was interested in partnering with the City on upgrades to the rec center pools to be able to host the boys and girls high school and junior high teams from both West High and Liberty High. Proud reviewed a proposed preliminary agreement with Neumann Monson to create a new master plan and to come up with costs for the improvements. The agreement costs \$151,000 and the school district would pay 40% of the costs of said agreement. The Council expressed general approval and Proud indicated that a 28E with the school district and agreement with Neumann Monson would come forward to a future Council meeting for approval.

Deputy City Administrator Habel indicated that there was a meeting regarding mobility transportation for employment on August 15, 2023 from 9-11 am and that she was seeking a council member to attend on behalf of the City.
