

**Coralville City Council
Work Session
August 9, 2022

Mayor Foster opened the meeting at 7:50 pm.

1. City Administrator's Time: Hayworth provided updates on the following:
 - The City is working with Johnson County and the CVB on an application to Destination Iowa and the theme will be Paddle and Pedal. Hayworth said the goal will be to combine water and trail activities and the group feels that an application from multiple communities will strengthen the application.
 - Deputy City Administrator Ellen Habel said staff provided a tour to representatives from the American Flood Center, who were interested in the work the City has done to protect from flooding and improve resiliency. Hayworth said the City will join the American Flood Center in the near future.
 - Habel said the RFP for work on the utility resilience project is due August 18 and was sent to six engineering firms. She said MidAmerican Energy agreed to assist with engineer selection and once selected, work should be complete by December 1.
 - Hayworth noted complaints about the companies installing fiber to homes are increasing and a third company has now expressed interest in installing fiber in Coralville.

Mayor Foster said she would like to add the following to future work session agendas: a presentation from the Johnson County mobility coordinator, a discussion on "ban the box," and an update on Auburn Ridge.
