

PROCEEDINGS OF THE CORALVILLE CITIZENS COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF SAID BOARD AT A SUBSEQUENT MEETING

A meeting of the Coralville Citizen's Community Policing Advisory Board was held at City Hall, 1512 7th Street on Monday, January 23, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM.

#2 Roll call. The following Board Members were present: Peterson, Slade, Morales, Leytem and Dolezal

The following City Staff was present: City Attorney Kevin Olson. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.

#3 Approve agenda. Motion by Slade, Seconded by Morales to approve the agenda. Motion carried all ayes.

#4 Minutes of November 28, 2022. Motion by Peterson seconded by Morales to approve the minutes of November 28, 2022 meeting with amendment. Motion carried all ayes.

#5. Community Experiences. Leytem explains the difference between Community Experiences and Public comment. Community Experiences would be a situation where the person doesn't want to file a complaint but wants to bring an issue up to the Board. Moved Community Experiences until before Motion to Adjourn awaiting comments but person not present as of yet.

#6. Public Comments. Mary McCann discussed about how often does today's training address fears and experience. Slade pointed out that childhood experiences permeate your whole life. Leytem stated the Board is always looking for training activities.

#7. Old Business.

- 1) Follow-up to council presentation. Told council concerns about the consultants reporting, suggested that Board could receive materials in advance. Advised council moved to bi-monthly meetings. Leytem suggested going to Council twice a year now.
