

PROCEEDINGS OF THE CORALVILLE CITIZENS COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF SAID BOARD AT A SUBSEQUENT MEETING

A meeting of the Coralville Citizen's Community Policing Advisory Board was held at City Hall, 1512 7th Street on Monday, May 22, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 PM.

#2 Roll call. The following Board Members were present: Hotsenpiller, Gosnell, Slade, Morales, Leytem and Dolezal

Absent: Peterson

The following City Staff was present: City Attorney Kevin Olson. Meeting called to order at 6:01 p.m.

#3 Approve agenda. Motion by Leytem, Seconded by Morales to approve the agenda. Motion carried all ayes.

#4 Minutes of November 28, 2022. Motion by Morales, seconded by Dolezal to approve the minutes of March 27, 2023 meeting with note that Member Gosnell was added as present at the last meeting. Motion carried all ayes.

#5. Community Experiences. Leytem explains that Council member brought a situation to the Board's attention regarding a police officer and a family who spoke only Arabic after tornado as their property was damaged. However, no follow up could be obtained from the person. Chair Hotsenpiller brought up a complaint she received about police handling of 10 yr-old from South Africa who ran away. Hotsenpiller attempted to follow up but person has yet to respond.

#6. Public Comments. None.

#7. Old Business.

- 1) Gosnell reported on training by Ashley Hopkins regarding racial bias through the Iowa State Extension. Gosnell gave a brief overview of the training and passed this information to Chief Kron.
- 2) Hotsenpiller briefed the Board on her experiences at the Citizen's Police Academy and reported upon her ride along, where she noted the officer engaged in more social service work and was impressed with the officer's patience and response to the situations they encountered.
- 3) Dennis Leytem reported that Board request to get traffic stop data before the presentation to the Board and that the presentation be recorded.

#8. New business. It was noted that Chairperson Hotsenpiller will brief the City Council on the Board's work for the next quarter sometime in the month of July.

#9. Next meeting July 24, 2023.

#10. Other business. Leytem noted the request by Mayor Foster to provide presentation about gun violence intervention to the Board. Slade also mentioned her disappointment in funding for mental health resources to assist persons and Gosnell shared her own work experience with that subject.

#11. Adjourn. Seeing no other business, Dolezal moved, seconded by Slade, to adjourn. All ayes.
