

PROCEEDINGS OF THE CORALVILLE CITIZENS COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF SAID BOARD AT A SUBSEQUENT MEETING

A meeting of the Coralville Citizen's Community Policing Board was held at City Hall, 1512 7th Street on Monday, September 27, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM.

Motion by Slade, seconded by Morales to approve the agenda. Ayes: 5, Motion carried.

1. Addition of standing agenda item of Community Experiences, a time for people to tell stories about their interactions with police- limited to approximately 15 minutes each

-Motion by Hotsenpiller, 2nd by Morales

-Ayes: 4, Motion carried

2. Changing 'Citizen Comments' to 'Public Comments' to avoid implying citizenship is required. A similar argument was made about changing the name of the board, but that was set by ordinance upon recommendation of the NAACP, and would require the City Council to act.

-Motion by Morales, 2nd by Hotsenpiller to change 'Citizen Comments' to 'Public Comments.'

-Ayes 5, Motion carried

3. Discussion about posting the agenda and updating the webpage to reflect the Advisory Board's agreed upon meeting dates as the fourth Monday of the month at 6PM at Coralville City Hall unless otherwise posted.

-Chief Kron will continue to post minutes and agendas on the designated webpage to ensure the Board remains compliant with Iowa open meetings law.

4. Discussion about forms used to make a complaint to the board. Police will provide the current complaint form and the Iowa Civil Rights Commission's complaint form prior to the October meeting.
