BY MAIL WITH YOUR PAPER UTILITY BILL | Add the donation to your payment. Write the donation amount in the box that says, "Optional Neighbors Helping Neighbors donation."

IN PERSON | Stop by City Hall, 1512 7th Street, open weekdays from 7:30 am to 5:00 pm (excluding holidays).

DROP OFF | Drop off a donation 24 hours a day at the drive-up/walk-up box by the City Hall parking lot, 1512 7th Street. Please place your donation in a sealed envelope and mark it with "Utility Assistance Fund."

All donations will assist Coralville residents. Funds will be distributed as they are available through United Way of Johnson and Washington Counties. Call 319.338.7823 if you need help with your bill.
