Soil quality restoration can improve soil health, reduce stormwater runoff, and build a greener, sustainable lawn without chemicals.

First, deep tine aeration creates macro-pores in the soil for deep drainage, breaks through compacted soil, and allows grass to form deeper roots. Then, a layer of compost is spread over the top as a recipe for yards to soak up more rain water.

Soil restoration projects can only be performed in the spring and fall, and enrollment is required before completing the work. Funding is limited and is available on a first come, first served basis.
