

Youth Volleyball Return To Play

This guidance was formed from various recommendations from Centers for Disease Control & Prevention and Iowa Department of Public Health as a resource for mitigation efforts to help ensure player, spectator and staff safety during voluntary summer sports activities.

Player & Team Safety:

1. No one should attend or participate in league play if they currently have symptoms or have been in contact with anyone with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis in the last 14 days.
2. Parents/Guardians should monitor their children's health by checking temperatures and watching for any symptoms of COVID-19 prior to bringing them to practices or games.
3. Players are encouraged after the game to wave to the opposing team, telling them good game. No handshakes!!
4. Play is limited to 6 on 6 per game or scrimmage. No more than 10 participants will be placed on a team. Participants not on the court should social distance on the sidelines.
5. Players must bring their own water bottles.
6. No handshakes, hugs, high fives, fist or elbow bumps, or any other deliberate contact.
7. Immediate family only. All family members will be required to wear a mask while in facility.
8. Frequency of cleaning at the facility has been increased however there is no guarantee that surfaces are sanitized at all times. This includes benches, bleachers, and restrooms
9. Players must provide their own hand sanitizer and antibacterial wipes for disinfecting hands. There will be hand sanitizer onsite also for players/fans if needed.
10. Players and spectators are asked to maintain social distancing in the facility before and after games. We encourage teams to play their games/practices and exit the facility following those events.
11. All players and spectators should accept personal responsibility for public health guidelines
12. When you are attending games/practices at the Coralville Recreation Center or GreenState Fieldhouse all players will be required to wear a mask at all times even during game/practice play. When playing at the North Liberty Recreation Center all players will be required to wear mask when not playing on the court, but has the choice to wear a mask when participating on the court.

Coaches

1. Wearing a mask is required.
2. The home team on the schedule will begin serving and teams will alternate after each game on who is serving.
3. Teams must be on opposite ends of the sidelines, and try to social distance amongst teammates.
4. All shared equipment will be wiped down after games are complete by recreation staff.
5. All program volunteers should use hand sanitizer frequently during the program.
