

RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 14

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022.

WHEREAS, Senate File 634 was approved on May 23, 2019 which aims to further notify the public about property tax changes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Coralville have considered the proposed Fiscal Year 2022 City Maximum Property Tax Dollars for the affected levy total; and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed City Maximum Property Tax Dollars was published as required and posted on the City website and social media accounts; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed City Maximum Property Tax Dollars was held on February 9, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Coralville, Johnson County, Iowa, that the Total City Maximum Property Tax Dollars for the affected levies for Fiscal Year 2022 shall not exceed \$17,329,055.00. The Maximum Property Tax Dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for Fiscal Year 2022 represents an increase of .55% from the Maximum Property Tax Dollars requested for Fiscal Year 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator and Director of Finance are hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the implementation of the same.


