EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2021, the United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC) has determined that persons who are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 virus can resume activities that they did prior to the pandemic without wearing a mask or socially distancing, except where required by other rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, vaccines are readily available in Coralville and Johnson County; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.02(2) of the Code of Ordinance of the City of Coralville and Section 372.14(2) of the Code of Iowa (2019) grant the Mayor powers to govern through proclamation to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Coralville,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John A. Lundell, the duly elected Mayor of the City of Coralville, Iowa, do hereby proclaim the following, effective immediately, that an emergency no longer exists within the City because of the community spread of the COVID-19 virus, and therefore, I rescind the proclamation of April 13, 2021:

Face coverings are no longer required in Coralville, except where required by other rules and regulations, which may include other local laws, federal laws, or the requirements of private organizations.
